**SEQR Motion:**

**Cary Redhead: Daisy - Dog**

Redhead said Daisy was found in the area of Bankrupt Rd, Biddlecum Rd and St Rt. 264 and was brought in to the Town. Redhead said she was in very poor condition. Hankey took the dog home and gave her a flea bath and clip her nails and cared for her the next couple days. Redhead said she made a vet apt. with Highland Animal Hospital. Daisy is considered a special needs dog when she came to us she had a right eye infection and had fun missing from her body, fleas and no teeth and partial jaw is gone and her tongue hangs out. Redhead said Daisy needs to have eye surgery and Highland will work with whomever takes her to their forever home she is very happy now so if you can pass the word around that she needs a forever home.

**WIIA Grant Money – Bankrupt Road**

Redhead said she pleased to announce the Town was awarded \$992,000.00 in grant money for the Bankrupt Road Water District through the EFC WIIA program. (Attached to minutes)

**JoAnn Nazarian: Justice Audit**
