**Justice Clerk Resignation**

**Water District BANS**

Nazarian said we have 3 BANS that are due which are 2 for County Route 12 and 1 for Oswego River Road. Gelling made the **Motion** to adopted the BANS with M&T for one year BANS which are Oswego River Road for \$6,250 renewal at the rate of 5.18% County Route 12, \$29,700. **Bankrupt Road Water BAN**

Nazarian said Bankrupt Road Water District invoice came in yesterday from Greene County Commercial Bank which is due June 1<sup>st</sup> she believes that it might be for full payment but isn't sure. Nazarian said we have allocated \$200,000.00 from Co-vid funding to fix our park. Nazarian said C2Ae provided us with a quote to help us with the upgrades. Gelling made the **Motion** to accept the bid from C2AE for the scope of work for \$8,430.00 seconded by N Hoyt. All aye Nazarian, Gelling, L. Hoyt, N. Hoyt and Redhead. (Attached to Minutes)
